

CONGREGATIONAL MEETING MINUTES

The November Meeting of the Congregation of the United Evangelical Church was held on Friday, November 25, 1966.

There were a total of (72) seventy two voting members present.

The meeting was opened with a prayer by Pastor Paul A. Rasche.

The first order of business was the reading of the minutes of the Congregational Meeting held on January 26, 1966. As the Recording Secretary was not available for the reading of the minutes this portion of the meeting was waived.

The second order of business was the election of new Council Board members for the year 1967.

The following members of the Congregation were nominated to run for the coming year by the Nominating Committee.

1. J. Albert Fader, Sr. - 2. Alfred Johnson, 3. Ernest W. Jones,
4. Robert Logue - 5. J. Carl MacGeorge, - 6. George Sauer, -
7. Leroy J. Sennett, - 8. Richard Single, and 9. William Single, III.

The Congregation was asked to vote for only six of the above nine candidates.

The President of the Church Council appointed the following members of the Congregation to officiate at the conducting of the election.

Presiding Official - William Voelker
Congregation Representative - Henry Neubert
Official Marker - Arthur A. Block

The following members were elected by the Congregation to serve for the coming year. Ernest W. Jones (67 votes) George Sauer (61 votes) J. Albert Fader, Sr. (59) votes Richard Single (57 votes), and William Single, III (54 votes) and Alfred Johnson (39) votes.

The third order of business was the discussion and passing of the Church Budget for the year 1967. After much discussion a total General Budget of \$54,018.00 was passed and a Special Budget of \$13,500.00 was also passed by the Congregation.

For the 1967 Total Budget of \$67,518.00 - 37 votes

As there was no further business to be brought before the Congregation at this time the meeting was adjourned. The meeting was closed with the Lord's Prayer.
