

The November meeting of the Congregation of the United Evangelical Church was held on Friday, November 24, 1967.

There were a total of 27 voting members present.

The meeting was opened with a prayer by Pastor Paul A. Lasche.

The first order of business was the reading of the minutes of the Congregational meeting held on January 27, 1967.

The second order of business was the election of new Council Board members for the year 1968.

The following members of the Congregation were nominated to run for the coming year by the Nominating Committee:

John Denning, Robert Logue, Fred Long, Louis Smith, William Walker and Louis Barker, Sr.

There being just six nominees to fill the six open Council Board seats - John Wills made a motion that these six men be elected as Council Board members for the years 1968 and 1969. Ernest Jones seconded this motion and it was unanimously carried.

President Fader informed the new Council Board members that installation would be made Sunday, Nov. 26, 1967. He also stated that Dec. 5 would be the first Council Board meeting and that the new officers of the Council Board would be elected at this meeting.

Mr. Fader thanked Louis Mueller, William Bark, Jr. and Arthur Black for serving so faithfully on the Council Board. He expressed the hope that these men would again serve on the Council Board in the future.

The third order of business was the passing of the Church Budget for the year 1968. Mr. Richard Single went over and explained each item on the \$62,233.00 proposed budget. Arthur Black made a motion that the proposed budget be approved as presented and Robert Logue seconded it. The motion was unanimously carried.

There being no other business to come before the congregation at this time the meeting was adjourned. The meeting was closed with the Lord's Prayer.
