- Real and leasehold property is not to be reported.
- Distilled spirits subject to ordinary taxes under Article 81, Section 23 to 28 inclusive, should be reported on form No. 13, and not on this form. Distillers raw materials, goods in process and supplies, used in connection with the manufacturing of distilled spirits in Maryland should be reported under 10b. This instruction applies only to Distillers and Public warehouses.

are hereby authorized, (1) to draw and sign checks on the corporate account with the Equitable Trust Company, Baltimore, Maryland; (2) to borrow money and obtain credit for this corporation from said Trust Company upon such terms as they may deem advisable, and to make and deliver to said Trust Company any instrument or instruments evidencing the indebtedness of this corporation, and as security therefore to pledge and hypothecate with said Trust Company any securities, evidences of indebtedness, negotiable or otherwise, and any other property, of whatsoever nature, of this corporation, and to endorse, guarantee or transfer the same in the name of this corporation, and in connection with any loan, pledge, or renewal thereof to execute and deliver to said Trust Company any and all instruments of assignment and transfer, contracts, trust receipts and any other documents which may be required by said Trust Company, with or without the corporate seal of this corporation affixed; (3) to discount with said Trust Company any bills receivable or negotiable paper belonging to this corporation, and to endorse or guarantee the same in the name of this corporation; (4) to have access to the Safe Deposit Box of the corporation at said Trust Company and to remove therefrom, or place therein, any papers, bonds, securities, or other property they may wish, and to renew, terminate or otherwise alter the contract or rental of said Safe Deposit Box, between this corporation and said Trust Company, upon such terms and in such manner as they may think best.
