

September 7, 1993

The regular monthly meeting of the Church Council of the United Evangelical Church U.C.C. was held on Tuesday, September 7, 1993.

Those in attendance were Ruth Beckwith, George Finnerty, George Hammerbacher, Harvey Jacob, Ben Long, George Nassner, Wayne Schaefer, James Tallagsen, Cass Young, and Pastor Armstrong.

George Hammerbacher, vice-president, presided over the meeting.

Pastor Armstrong opened the meeting with prayer.

John Price came to the meeting to get our approval to go ahead with putting all church records into the computer. John has estimated we have over 67,000 records to be computurized.

Harvey Jacob made a motion that we support the program to computurize all church records and James Tallagsen seconded. All Concil members were in agreement with this motion.

The minutes were approved as read.

The financial report was approved as presented by Harvey. We are \$10,328 under budget at this time.

Correspondence

We received a letter from Dale and Lynn Sanders thanking us for letting their family use the hall for a baby shower for Lynn.

We also received a letter from D.C. Impact thanking us for letting them rent the gym for their classes in November and December.

A letter was received from Pastor Glen E. Rogers of Bethel United Church of Christ requesting a meeting with Pastor Armstrong to discuss the possibility of a merger with United Evangelical. (See Attached)

Jim Tallagsen made a motion to approve the discussion between Pastor Armstrong and Pastor Rogers on the merger and Ben Long seconded. The Council members were all in favor of this motion.

We received a letter from the United Church Of Christ Insurance Advisory Board in answer to the letter Pastor wrote to them in August. (See attached)

The WIC program was explained to us again by Pastor. George Finnerty, Harvey Jacob, and Bucky Carrigan observed the program at it's present location. George and Harvey gave report on their observation. They found the program to be a good one and helpful to those in need of it's service.

George Finnerty made a motion we accept the WIC program and remuneration for our facilities provided that acceptable terms can be worked out. Harvey seconded the motion and Jim Tallagson, Wayne Schaefer, and Ben Long were not in favor of the motion. The remaining Council members were in favor of the motion.
