

## BY-LAWS AS OF 1947

Name: Young Women's Guild Of the United  
Evangelical Reformed Church

Membership:

Entrance age 18 years.

Organization:

a. Officers:

1. President
2. Vice President
3. Secretary
4. Treasurer
5. Corresponding Secretary

- b. Each Officer must be an active member of the Young Women's Guild.

Amendments:

This constitution may be amended by 2/3 vote of the members. The amendment must be submitted in writing and added to the constitution if voted upon at the next meeting.

## BY-LAWS

### Article I - Meeting

Sect. 1 - Regular meetings of the Guild shall be held 3rd Wednesday evening of the month.

Sect. 2 - The annual meeting shall be

held in November at which time full reports of the year's work will be presented.

## Article II - Nominations, Elections, Term Of Office

Sect. 1 - Nomination committee shall be appointed by the President in October. This committee shall submit name for the coming year.

Sect. 2 - The officers shall be elected by closed ballot at the November meeting.

Sect. 3 - Newly elected candidates may hold office for two years. They cannot be re-elected for any office until one year has passed.

## Article III - Duties Of The Officers

Sect. 1 - President - Preside at all meetings and appoints all committees.

Sect. 2 - Vice-President - The vice-president is to see to it that the chair-ladies of all committees carry out their duties.

Sect. 3 - Secretary - she should keep correct minutes and complete roll of members. She is the custodian of by-laws and constitution.

Sect. 4 - Treasurer - She should keep accurate record of money and disbursements of all cash.

Sect. 5 - Corresponding Secretary - shall notify members of all regular and special meetings, when requested by the president.

Article IV - Finances:

Sect. 1 - Dues 25¢ per month or **\$3.00** per year.

Sect. 2 - Money Made:

- a. Oyster Supper-Bazaar - entire amount to be turned over to church.
- b. Chicken Supper-Bazaar - entire money turned over to Guild Treasury.
