Brief History of United Evangelical Church

German immigrants organized our church in September 1873. Early services were conducted in German and in 1894 the English language was first used in a service.

In 1915 stained glass windows were installed in the old church. In 1920 the "Lighted Clock Tower" was created and has recently been rebuilt so as to shine over the Canton-Highlandtown community. The ringing of the bells, toll a message of security and God's ever-present care over members, neighbors, and friends.

In 1927 the Church became affiliated with the Evangelical Synod of North America. In 1937 the cornerstone for the present parsonage and church was set. We are presently worshiping in the church that was dedicated in 1957 to the "Glory of God." Having merged with the United Church of Christ our name was changed to United Evangelical United Church of Christ. Our worship services reflect a combination of the Catholic, German Evangelical Lutheran Church, and the Reformed tradition of our spiritual forebearers from the Congregational Church. We play a major role in working with other neighborhood churches of various denominations.

United is a member of the Chesapeake Association and the Central Atlantic Conference of the United Church of Christ. It has a rich heritage in both religious tradition and the service to the Canton-Highlandtown communities. Members are inheritors of a great history and see themselves today as "children of God" and "followers of the Way" of Christ.

In essentials unity, in non-essentials diversity, in all things charity.

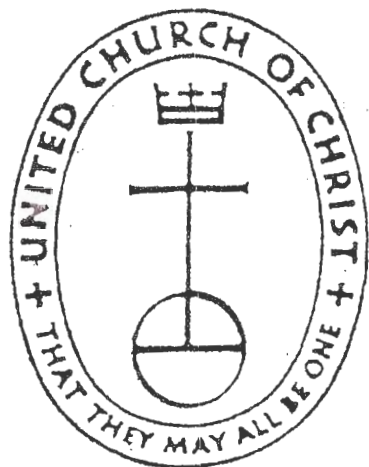
