REPORTS OF COMMITTEES

1. CANVAS - Mr. Henry Holten reported that all the mailing for Visitation etc. had been handled. The Pastor stated as soon as the files have been brought up to date, a return visitation will be in order.
2. FELLOWSHIP - Mr. Long will get prices from caterers for an affair to honor Dr. Titus Lehmann on his 50 years in the Ministry. Also, Mr. Long will hold meeting with heads of various organizations at our Church.
3. PROPERTY - Mr. Mueller will check into the water leaking in one of the bedrooms at the parsonage. Mrs. Margaret Brunner of the Sundayschool would like permission to purchase two air conditioners to be placed in her Department. Mr. Fader will check to see what size air conditioner Mrs. Brunner is considering so that there are proper circuits available to handle same.

Mr. Fader will call Bozman Refrigeration to come down and pump water to the tank for the Church air conditioner.

Mr. Bond reported that work on the Fellowship Hall has been started.

Mr. Kurt Lindner is making repairs to the chairs and tables in the Sundayschool.
