REPORTS OF COMMITTEES

PROPERTY - The idea of installing an iron gate in the Sunday-school Hall at the stair landing was discussed and a motion was made by Mr. William Bark to install same. Mr. Carl Schroeder seconded the motion and same was carried.

After a discussion concerning the storage box at the west wall of the auditorium being a hazard, a motion was made by Mr. Norman Fritze and seconded by Mr. Carl Schroeder to remove same from the auditorium.

A meeting is to be held by Mr. George Hammerbacher and his committee to discuss and layout the duties of the sexton.

Mr. Hammerbacher then reported the Church doors are in a deplorable condition. He will advise the Council further at our next meeting.

Mr. John Bond brought up the idea of installing a permanent screen in the Friendship Hall. A motion was made by Mr. George Hammerbacher and seconded by Mr. Henry Holten to give Mr. Bond permission to install same.

A motion was made by Mr. Louis Mueller and seconded by Mr. George Hammerbacher to give Mr. George Smith authority to purchase two new standards for the flags in the Church.

FINANCE - Mr. William Claridge reported they will start work on the Church Budget and a report will be ready in August.

CANVAS - Mr. Carl Schroeder and Mr. Henry Holten reported the new Church records are in progress of being typed, but help is needed. The Council will consider hiring someone outside of the Church to help type these records.
