

November 29, 1963

The regular scheduled meeting of the Congregation was called to order on the above date by our President, Mr. J. Albert Fader and we opened our meeting with prayer by Pastor Rasche.

Mr. Fader then submitted proposed budget for year 1964 and Mr. Ernest Jones explained the new budget to the congregation. A motion was made by Mr. J. Edwin Myers to accept the proposed budget for 1964; seconded by Mr. J. William Laukeman. Motion was carried.

Mr. Fader brought up the idea of changing the time of our early service on Sunday mornings, and after some discussion on this matter it was decided to have a trial period, if necessary, for the services to begin at 7:45 A.M. in an attempt to determine how this would meet with the approval of the congregation and also how it would effect our attendance at this early service. Or, as an alternative it was suggested that perhaps the service could begin at 8:00 A.M. (as has been) but omit/or shorten the service in some manner. ^{responses etc.} This will be given some consideration between now and our next meeting.

ELECTION OF COUNCIL MEMBERS

Mr. William Bark explained to the congregation the need for an Intern Minister at our Church. Also, the matter of expense involved in having an Intern Minister was mentioned. Mr. BARK stated that he hoped we would be able to have an Intern Minister by September, 1964.

There was no further business to come before the Congregation at this time. Therefore, a motion was made by Mr. J. Edwin Myers and seconded by Mr. Ernest Jones that the meeting be adjourned.
