Mr. F. Long reported that the total profit on the Oyster/Sour Beef supper was \$1,377.47

Renovation of Church School Building - Mr. E. Myers gave a report from Building Committee (copy attached) and Mr. R. Single gave report with regards to financing of the project (report attached. At this point a 15 minute recess was called in order to take a tour thru the building to show the people the condition of same. Bark & seconded by Mr. W. Laukeman authorizing the Church Council the authority to bind the Church with a \$40,000.00 mertgage. All three motions carried

an unanimous vote.
