Ladies and Gentlemen:

The Chesapeake Association of the United Church of Christ, of which you are a part, has unanimously adopted and pledged full support to the Every Church Visitation, the first step in "BREAKTHROUGH". It remains for you and this committee to implement this program in your congregation.

Briefly, the purpose of the Every Church Visitation is to sharpen our understanding of Our Christian World Mission to the world as it is carried out on the local scene, in the conference area, and throughout the nation and the world. Also it will help us to involve ourselves in this common task and raise the monetary support needed to accomplish this wider mission. It will be conducted in the interests of helping the local church to assume its responsibility for the new program of the United Church of Christ.

Two visitors who have been thoroughly trained will visit your Church to explore with your leaders your congregations participation in the enlarging mission of the United Church.

We therefore request your full cooperation in this enriching endeavor by:

1. Selecting a date between September 19 and October 12, 1965 when two visitors may meet with your consistory, committee chairman, auxiliary organization heads, and other key persons within your congregation.

2. Postpone finalizing the benevolent portion of your 1966 budget ( it at all possible ) until after the visitation.

3. Issuing an effective call to all key persons in your congregation to attend this visitation session in order to gain maximum benefits from this positive service to our fellow christians

A prompt reply on the enclosed card is necessary to implement this program for all our churches. We sincerely believe that this venture in service will benefit your congregation and we anxiously await your reply.
