Gentlemen:

Regarding work to be done to interior of north and east walls, in rooms on second and third floors, in rear of Church School Building, I propose to furnish labor and material to do the work for the sum of (\$2800.00).

Walls to be furred with 3/4" thick stripping, spaced 16" on centers and fastened over present plastered walls with case hardened nails. A 15 lb. asphalt sheathing felt to be put over strips before applying finished plywood wall panneling, size 4'0" x 8'0" and 1/4" thick, with tawny oak finish as per sample.

Cut door opening in wall between fellowship hall and proposed kitchen on first floor, and install a dutch door for the sum of (\$275.00).

All electrical, plumbing, heating and painting in connection with the above work to be done by others.
