Hello Ed:

Regarding the information you asked me to get on these machines, I have not been able to come up with too much that will be of any help to you.

1. I talked to Sam Silber who told me he gets his machines from Globe Ticket Co. Mr. Warner Collins PI 2-1249. When I called them and told them what we wanted, she says that Silbers bakery themselves called her not too long ago re! a church in Highlandtown (United) and that she sent info to them pertaining to the machines. She is going to send some additional info to you however, as I wasn't sure what the name of your church was.
2. I talked to MODERN STAMP MFG. CO. and they do not have the machines but they do have the individual numbers that hang on racks, such as are used in some stores. The people would take a number from the rack, hold it until called and then return the number to you to use over again when the numbers run out.

A rack with numbers 1 thru 50 would cost \$ 11.40

A rack with numbers 1 thru 100 would cost \$ 18.70

This is about the best I can do for you on this, sorry I couldn't be more help.
