BUILDING COMMITTEE  
RENOVATION OF CHURCH SCHOOL BUILDING

OBJECTIVE:

To refurbish the building inside and out. Building is approximately 30 years old, there is consistent maintenance that has to be done and it is getting costly to keep in repair.

PROPOSAL:

New roof, waterproof outside walls, all window frames to be recaulked and outside woodwork painted.

Wiring inadequate, lighting very poor through out building with the exception of Fellowship room.

Installation of additional bathroom facilities

Floor covering through out, similar to the Fellowship floor.

Entire heating plant to be overhauled.

Auditorium - Replacement of wooden floor with a cement floor.

RECOMMENDATION:

Tour of building

Have individual contractors do the work rather than turn job over to a general contractor who would sub-let.

Have bid from general contractor, cost approximately \$40,000. If we do as suggested above there could be a substantial savings.


FINANCE:
