It is the desire of our Church School, to further the work of God in our community. We must constantly remind and educate the people of the community who attend our Church School in the way our Lord would want us to live. To this end, we dedicate our time and efforts.

In this coming year, to better carry on the work of Christian Education, we are completing some plans and carrying on others. We hope to begin new plans to help us obtain a Church School that is worthy of our constant changing standards.

Your present General Superintendent completes his tenure of office in Nov. of 1965, and must step down. His office along with others must be filled, and teachers and workers too are needed. Please make it known, that with the Church School growing as it is, we need help in all Departments.

This year will see the completion of the purchase of lesson material begun over one year ago. This material will round out the two year course of the United Church Curriculum. This year will also complete our first round of the course.

We are also in the process of strengthening our audio visual aid library, and adding to its effectiveness. More 35 MM filmstrips are being purchased to help each department along with recordings to present these film. Some of the film now in our files are; Life of Jesus, Life of Paul, Life of Moses, Old Testament Prophets, and Life's World Religion series. These are some of the larger series. Many others are available to our congregation on request. To make it easier for each Dept. to use these film, projectors and players along with stands and extension cords will be permanently located on each floor of the Church School.

Our latest plans are for the modernization of our Church School Building and furnishing of each Dept. with new furniture to replace the old and worn equipment we are now using. We hope to have work on our Church School begin in this year 1965. The Church Council has appointed a Building Committee, and this group is at work now formulating plans. for this latest project.

The Church School is growing in attendance to its present enrollment of approximately 500 students and workers, and our needs are ever increasing. We pray God that we may grow as an organization to keep pace with these needs.
