Please attach this Addendum to the copy of the Specifications loaned you for bidding purposes. This Addendum is hereby made a part of the contract documents on which the General Contract will be based, and is issued to modify and change the original Specifications and Drawings.

- A. Addenda Nos. 1 and 2 are superseded by this Addendum No. 3. The following detailed references are made for the various items in Addenda Nos. 1 and 2.
- B. Addendum No. 1:
- (a) Drawing No. 2-T, Basement Floor Plan - Column has been shown on drawing.
  - (b) Drawing No. 4-T, 5th Floor Plan of Tower - this has been shown on the drawing.
  - (c) Drawing No. 6-T, Air Conditioning Machinery Room - Framing plans have been shown on drawing.
  - (d) Drawings No. 7-T, 8-T, 20-T, 21-T, and 22-T - the changes and/or corrections called for in Addendum No. 1 have been shown on the drawings. Attention is called to the fact that item (c) in Addendum No. 1, under Drawing No. 22-T, refers to Sections A-A and B-B. These have been relettered Sections X-X and Y-Y to eliminate duplication of symbols.

B. Addendum No. 1 (Cont'd):

(e) Drawing No. 34-T:--

- (1) Sanitary Plumbing Layout - No change from Addendum No. 1.
- (2) Storm Water Drains - No change from Addendum No. 1.
- (3) Sub-Surface Building Foundation Drains - To be superseded by the requirements called for in Addendum No. 2. (This revision has also been shown on the drawing.)

(f) Specification Changes:--

- (1) The alternate on sheet piling will be changed to a "cost plus 10 percent" basis, whether it be wood or steel sheet piling. Such work shall only be done upon written order of the Owner authorizing sheet piling installation.
- (2) Rear wall waterproofing - To be done as instructed by the Architect.
- (3) Bond -- No change; bond to be furnished by the Contractor, premium to be included in the bid price.

C. Addendum No. 2:

- (1) Item B of Addendum No. 2 -- Changes to Basement Robing Rooms.






