Dear Confirmand:

The final examination will be held on Thursday, April 2nd at 7:30PM. Confirmation will take place on Palm Sunday, April 12, 1992 at 10:30AM. Three members of the Church Council will ask the questions and listen to your written statement of faith. In the next few weeks, I will help you to prepare this. For the exam you must be able to recite the Apostles Creed, the Ten Commandments, and the Lord's Prayer. You will be asked to answer the questions which I have enclosed and write a brief statement of your faith which you will read for the Council.

Because of our Wednesday Lenten Services at 7:30PM, Youth Choir will meet on Thursday at 6:30PM, Youth Group at 7:00PM, and Confirmation Class at 7:30PM.

Robes have been ordered for Confirmands assuming you will pass the examination. I have also included a list of Confirmands. We need you to check the spelling of your name so that it can be properly inscribed in the Bible you will be presented on the day of your graduation. If your name is not spelled correctly please get in touch with the office before Thursday, March 5th or let me know on that date. Shortly, we will be notifying you about the Class Picture. Also each person will get an individual picture. There will be a charge for this. Last year the cost was \$8.00. Should this be a problem, please notify me.

We look forward to your becoming a member of the church but are serious about your preparation for this examination. Next week we will review the Ten Commandments as enclosed. Please memorize these.
