

September 4, 1990

The regular monthly meeting of the United Evangelical United Church of Christ was held on Tuesday, September 4, 1990 at 7:30 pm, president, Mr. Clarence Rowell, presiding. All members were in attendance except for Mr. Fred Long, Mr. Jacobs, and Mr. Carrigan.

The minutes and financial reports were approved as read.

Correspondence

We received a letter from the Chesapeake Association. The fall dinner installation meeting will be held on October 14. Ben Long will attend with Pastor Hamilton. There is still room for one more person.

Property

1. The dishwasher in the parsonage is broken.
2. The back door is finished, but the intercom still needs to be installed.
3. The gym is half done--we are waiting for the tiles. Mrs. Young will try to get us a discount on drapes from Epstein's.
4. Mr. Tallagsen suggested that we expand our current phone system so that we will have three lines going into the church. There would be a one time charge of \$32 for this plus a hookup charge of \$64. If extra wiring was needed it would be \$40 plus \$16 a hour service charge. The monthly rate would be \$57 plus \$.10 a call. A motion was made that we accept this proposal as stated by Mr. Tallagsen. (Parker/F. Gundlach) Approved.
5. Mr. Tallagsen will prepare a breakdown of how much we spent on the church, the parsonage and the Church School Building. We will put this information in the bulletin. It was suggested that we give two free tickets to the supper to the contractor because he has saved us a lot of money. Approved.
