We hereby submit specifications and bid for:

1. Refinish (4) "oak" main entrance doors (East Ave. ) with "high grade" (2) coats of Marine Spar (tung) varnish.
2. Recoat trimmings (1) coat (hinge additions, locks, etc.) with Marine Gloss "black".
3. Refinish (2) Entrance Doors "red" to Sunday School Building, exterior side.
4. Provide and Install maximum heavy-duty automatic door closer for (1) Entrance Door to Sunday School Building and maximum heavy-duty Safety Chain.
5. Touch-up welds, bare areas, etc. on newly installed Steel Ramp for Auxiliary Entrance Door.
6. Remove (5) Steel welded window grates for lower hall windows. Reglaze where needed. Prime coat and finish coat in similiar shade-"brown", exterior Duron Finishes.
7. Reinstallation of "grates" to be installed by others. Quote cannot be provided. Reference is made to "Tex's Welding Service", 325-6100.
