After contacting both companies for some adjustments, Sam has Council's permission to choose either company and proceed with the ramp.

Sam purchased six Hunter ceiling fans, cencor operated, for a cost of \$131.00 each. Pipes were also purchased, to hang the fans on from the ceiling, for a cost of \$7.00 each. Vittek Electric Co. will install them for \$450.00. The cost of fans and installation is about \$1300.00. Fans will be installed in the next couple of weeks.

Door on quiet room will not close properly. Sam suggested that the stripe plate be adjusted.
