Sam Jones asked"What are the projections of the Fund Raising Committee in 1992?" Harvey Jacob told of the **Valentine Dance in February** and the sale of entertainment books. The Committee will be having a meeting on December 10, 1991 to project new projects for 1992.

Louis Parker said he takes great comfort in the job Pastor Armstrong is doing for our congregation and he expects Pastor' work to blossom.

Margaret Craig and her traveling friends donated \$505.00. We greatly appreciate this donation.

Marcella Surdel turned in the profit from the dance classes to the church in the sum of \$900.00, \$300.00 to the organ fund and \$600.00 for the six ceiling fans for Friendship Hall.

Frank Klima brought up the issue of using alcohol at church

affairs, stating that the article in the Church **Bulletin** each Sunday is ridiculous and if the Church Council cannot settle this issue, to put the motion before the Congregation to get the final answer YES or NO! Clarence Rowell explained that the Council cannot settle this issue. It must be settled by the Congregation by a vote. Pastor explained the Spirtual aspects of this issue.

Grace Fader explained the purchase of new pots and kitchen equipment to Lois Duvall which was badly needed in the kitchen. The three Women' Organizations donated \$1139,00 for this new kitchen equipment.

Harvey Jacob informed the congregation that the computer will soon be in the Church office.

Elsie Steyck was not in favor of alcohol being used at Church Affairs.

No further business to come before the Congregation, Frank Klima motioned we adjourn and Carol Rowell second the motion. Pastor closed with a prayer.
