
Dear Colleague:

GOOD NEWS! Seldom do we hear that today except in the Church so let me share it with you in this letter!

THE INTERFAITH MUSIC FESTIVAL FOR CANTON HIGHLAND TOWN to be held on Sunday, December 8th at 3:00PM is on. The attached list of churches are in the process or have committed themselves to participation. The purpose is to raise money for support of the SUPERPANTRY - (A way to help women who are single person heads of households to get off welfare and to become gainfully employed so they can help break the welfare cycle and teach their children how to become independent) and to express our mutual thanks to God for sending us a baby - his own Son at Christmas! Currently the Maryland Food Committee funds the SUPERPANTRY. With the proposed State welfare cuts this may be impossible in the new year. Therefore we must raise about \$2000 to do it ourselves. Eventually the SUPERPANTRY will be the way to used by our State rather than simply continuing to provide emergency food so we will be contributing to the entire State. This way brings new life, hope, dignity, and empowerment to those most in need. We must succeed in demonstrating that it can be done. Rather than give them a fish, teach them how to fish!

On Thursday, October 17th at 1:00PM at United we will convene a meeting of interested Churches to plan this affair. Please come and help us to plan or send a representative. Be sure to let us know what musical contribution you will be making to this important event. The Festival will be held at Messiah Lutheran Church. The cost of the tickets will be \$3.00 per person. This is a great opportunity to do something significant at Christmas time and to join forces with Christian friends in the neighborhood in making a permanent contribution toward helping the poor.
