
Dear Reverend Armsrong,

Notice is given that CHARLES R. REID, 1800 Hanford Road, Baltimore, Maryland 21237, was, on August 29, 1935, appointed personal representative of the estate of Emily M. Fiehrer, who died on August 18, 1935, with a will.

(2) Two months after the personal representative mails or otherwise delivers to the creditor a copy of this published notice or other written notice, notifying the creditor that the claim will be barred unless the creditor presents the claims within two months from the mailing or other delivery of the notice.

A claim not presented or filed on or before that date, or any extension provided by law, is unenforceable thereafter. Claim forms may be obtained from the Register of Wills.
