

March 30, 1993

The April United Evangelical Church Council meeting was held on Tuesday, March 30 as the normal scheduled meeting would have been during Holy Week.

The meeting was called to order at 7:32 p.m. by Council President, Clarence Rowell. Those members in attendance were: Clarence Rowell, Harvey Jacob, Bill Voelker, Jim Tallagsen, George Finnerty, George Nassner, Wayne Schaefer, Ruth Beckwith, and Pastor Armstrong.

The minutes of the March 2 meeting were read and approved as written.

The financial report, although incomplete as March had not ended, was given by Harvey Jacob and approved as presented. Harvey had to withdraw \$10,000 from Hopkins Federal to deposit in checking account to cover March expenses. We are approximately \$18,000 under budget through March, due in large part to church being cancelled one Sunday **because of snow** and attendance was very poor at one Wednesday service due to the weather, a large insurance bill was paid, and the bill for the new carpeting was paid.

- \*Letter from D.C. IMPACT Self Defense stating dates of programs and confirming that they would pay \$15 an hour for use of our facility. Certificate of insurance was attached.

- \*Letter from Sharon Daniloski re: Concerns over how Confirmation classes are set up (ages of children) and the ages of children allowed to acolyte. This letter of concern was referred to the Christian Education Committee for review and recommendations in establishing the format for future confirmation classes. Committee will meet sometime after Easter.

#### Property

- \*150 new metal chairs have been ordered for Friendship Hall.
- \*Jim Tallagsen indicated that there was much concern about smoking being allowed in the building and wanted to know about posting "no Smoking" signs. A motion was made by Bill Voelker, seconded by George Massner, and approved unanimously to prohibit smoking completely in the church and church school buildings. Appropriate signs will be posted.
- \*Jim expressed concern about the communion supplies being stored in a cabinet in the balcony and the safety hazard presented to those members of the Altar Committee when they have to carry the supplies down the stairs.

It was decided to place an attractive wooden cabinet in the Quiet Room in which to store the communion supplies. It was felt that they would be more convenient to those setting up the altar for communion as well as being more secure. Jim Tallagsen will take care of this matter.

A committee meeting will be held on April 21 at 4:00 p.m. to discuss "Marketing of United Evangelical Church" in hopes of developing a plan to increase our membership.
