A special meeting of the Church Council of the United Evangelical Church, U.C.C. was held on Tuesday, August 3, 1993.

Those in attendance were Clarence Rowell, Harvey Jacob, Ruth Beckwith, George Hammerbacher, George Nassner, George Finnerty, Jim Tallagsen, Bucky Carrigan, Cass Young, and Pastor Armstrong.

The main issue raised was the rental of the Church School building too the Maryland Food Committee. The Pastor gave information on the WIK program to the Council. This program will give aid to young mothers and their children. The Food Committee would like to use the second floor of our Church School building for this program.

A committee was formed consisting of Bucky Carrigan, George Finnerty, and Pastor Armstrong to observe the program at it's present location. Harvey Jacob hopes to join them. The committee will observe the program and report back to us at our September meeting of their findings. The Council will then decide if they will rent the building and vote on the issue.

A motion was made by Cass Young and seconded by George Nassner for D. C. Impact to use our facilities November 7,14,21, and December 4, 1993. All Council members were in favor of the motion.

A motion was made by George Finnerty and seconded by Harvey Jacob to have the Memorial Board redone in the Narthex. A price was given by Jim Pate, \$4.50 per. plate and 100 blank plates at 65¢ each. The plates will be put back in the same order they are in now.

All Council members were in favor of this motion.

A motion was made by Harvey Jacob and seconded by Ruth Beckwith to have the Interfaith Music Festival in our church on December 5, 1993. All Council members were in favor of this motion..

A motion was made by Bucky Carrigan and seconded by Ruth Beckwith to move the Boy Scouts to the third floor of the Sunday School building. They now occupy the second floor. All Council members were in favor of this motion.

Council approved Dance Classes to be resumed in September.

A motion was made by George Nassner and seconded by George Finnerty for John Price to purchase a program for the computer to record all church records. All Council members approved this motion.

Pastor Armstrong also brought to our attention our coverage on our insurance policy covering sexual abuse. (See attached)

Bill Raddatz, choir president has made a request for new robes for the Senior Choir. They will cost around \$2000.00. We will discuss this issue at our next meeting and get back to Bill with our decision.

Robert Gundlach, music director, has given us a list of things done and things that need to be done to the organ. (See attached)
