

June 7, 1966

The regular monthly meeting of our Church Council held at United Evangelical Church was called to order on Tuesday, June 7th, by our President, Mr. J. Albert Fader and opened with prayer by Pastor Rasche.

The reading of the minutes of the meeting held on May 3rd were read and approved. The financial report of receipts and expenditures was discussed and approved.

REPORTS OF COMMITTEES

Property: Mr. Sauer stated that we should take into consideration the idea of building a planter in front of parsonage. Mr. Sauer was given permission to get a price on this.

Mr. Mueller will take a look at the molding in the auditorium and report on same.

A motion was made by Mr. Sauer to increase Mrs. Bentrup's salary (\$45.00) - \$5.00 increase effective June 6, 1966. Motion was seconded by Mr. William Single.

A letter was received from Mrs. Grace Fader, President of the Women's Guild, requesting additional dishes for the kitchen, as well as additional chairs. The Property Committee will check into this and report their findings to the Finance Committee.

A motion was made by Mr. Mueller to purchase a Speed-O-Print Electric Addressograph for \$239.00, less 20%, plus incidentals.

Finance: Mr. Fader stated that there is a need of some one else to sign checks. A motion was made by Mr. Richard Single that the existing bank resolution be amended to include the name of Mr. William Single III as an authorized signatory. This was seconded by Mr. William Bark.

Ushering: Mr. Voelker suggested that we look into the matter of enlisting some new boys for ushering because of the fact that some of our young boys are going into the service.

Tuesday, June 21st, has been set aside as the first meeting date of the entire Enlistment Committee.

OLD BUSINESS

Mr. Richard Single is to contact Mr. Donald Schnader to determine if he would be available should we be in need of an organist. The Music Committee will attempt to secure names of some organists who are available.

NEW BUSINESS

Mrs. Fader has requested the week of July 17th to 24th for her vacation, as well as the week of October 16th to 22nd.

Mrs. Carrie Bentrup has selected July 24th to 31st as her vacation time.

Pastors Hilfiker and Tomasak will serve as Pastors in the absence of Pastor Rasche during his vacation. Each of these Pastors will receive \$25.00 per Sunday for their services. A motion was made by Mr. Bark and seconded by Mr. Richard Single to pay the sums as stated for preaching while Pastor Rasche is on vacation.

Pastor Rasche remarked that the insert of the billboard is becoming quite worn and suggested that same be repaired. Mr. Block will check into this matter.

Mr. William Single stated that an item should be placed in the Sunday Bulletin showing the weekly attendance, money needed and money collected. Church Council was in agreement with this.

There was no further business to come before the Church Council at this time. The meeting was adjourned with prayer.
