

September 6, 1966 ①

Meeting called to order at 8 P.M. by J. Albert Fisher & opened with a prayer by Pastor Rasche.

The minutes of the previous meeting were approved as corrected. Financial report was discussed and approved. Decision to be made to pick up - on financial report - the status of the improvement fund envelopes.

Discussion had as to the procedure to be followed for the repayment of both bonds & monies borrowed for the church school renovation. Matter referred to the Finance Committee for study & report to the Council.

Reports of Committees

Property - Parsonage planter. Mr. Saver reported that Contractor gave estimate of \$395.⁰⁰ to perform the necessary work. Pastor reported that rain did come into the basement during the last rainstorm.

Discussion had on the above matter and the decision made to brick up the windows & concrete up to the wall without a planter. Motion was made by Mr. Arthur Block, & seconded by Wm. Single to authorize George Saver to have the above work done at a cost not exceeding \$150.⁰⁰

Steel cabinet for Youth Fellowship - Louis Parker reported that he has not been successful in obtaining same. Mr. Parker to obtain same - Youth Fellowship to pay for it.

Bulletin board insert - Ed Schwartz reported that the original bulletin board purchased from ACE in Thila. Pa. Pastor Rasche will attempt to contact the above concern.

FINANCE - Progress

Membership → Bill Burk reported progress being made on Enlistment Program. Wants 100 people or 50 teams to conduct door-to-door surveys.
