I have been reading your book titled (USING DBASE IV 1.5) trying to learn how to create a UDF in dbase IV without success. This book seems to assume that the reader is familiar with many of the terms applied to creating a UDF, which I am not.

I was wondering if there is a book, written by you or someone else, that explains how to create a UDF or procedure in a laymans terms. That is, explain each step of the way, along with full examples, so that a person with a limited or no knowledge of programming could follow.

My other thought is, that with your knowledge of DBASE IV, you should write a book with many fully operating examples of a UDF as well as a procedure along with a full explanation of each one. The explanation should indicate which items in the UDF or procedure should be replaced with the readers items. SUCH A BOOK I WOULD BUY AT ALMOST ANY PRICE.

At the present time, I would like to search for a given person within the database by his LAST NAME and his DATE OF BIRTH. But, I would like to do this within the application that I have already created, or within the forms box of the control center.

{{[ MY PROBLEM IS ]}}

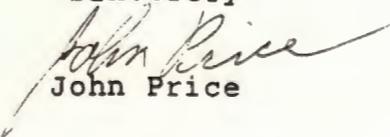
Recently, as a member of my church, I took the responsibility for committing our 120 year old records of the UNITED EVANGELICAL CHURCH to computer memory. My database contains 79 fields that covers everything from BAPTISM through BURIAL, and my forms and applications are designed accordingly. However after I enter the BAPTISM data for the past 120 years, I would like to search on any LAST NAME and DATE OF BIRTH field so that I do not duplicate a name that is already in the BAPTISM data, or, append data to the wrong person when entering MARRIAGE or CONFIRMATION data. ((((( The program, as is, works fine so long as I know which person to append MARRIAGE, CONFIRMATION or other data to.))))))

Since I do not know the people who were baptized 120 years ago, I need some way to search the records on the last name and date of birth before I enter MARRIAGE OR CONFIRMATION data. I would like to do this without going to the queries part of the database, which would take considerable time.

Finally, is it possible for one of your technicians to write a UDF for us at an agreed upon price.

Procedures set forth for entering data must be strictly adhered to in order to obtain a meaningful report or search.

Items marked with an astrict (\*) must me included with every first time record entered. Once entered, it does not have to be done again.

In the numeric field, the 1 means that 1 person was transferred, baptized, married, confirmed or died. The field selected will give a total, after any period of time depending on which field the 1 was entered in.

In item 28, the MINISTER-**B** performed the **baptism** ceremony  
 In item 29, the comments-**B** should refer to the **baptism** ceremony  
 In item 33, the MINISTER-**C** performed the **confirmation** ceremony  
 In item 34, The comments-**C** should refer to the **confirmation** ceremony  
 In item 58, the MINISTER **M** performed the **marriage** ceremony  
 In item 59, the comments-**M** should refer to the **marriage** ceremony  
 in item 65, the MINISTER-**F** performed the **funeral** services  
 In item 66, the comments-**F** should refer to the **funeral** services as well as a possible eulogy or something about that person that should be remembered down through the ages.

In time, with exception of a few fields, the whole document will be filled out on a person who was baptized, confirmed, married and buried at this church.

It should be understood that the information contained in the old books do not provide us with all of the data we are asking for in the database. However, when the data that is available is entered we will be able to search and locate anything in the books.

This database will allow us to search on any of the fields listed above and in any sequence.
