



I JOHN 3:18-24

To go to church can be dangerous. We can sing, pray, and talk about love, then feel that we have actually put love into action when, in fact, we have not. How comfortable it is to bask in a cozy group of fellow church-members, many of them congenial friends. The gospel calls us out of non-action like that. It asks us to make love a verb, to give practical help to people who may live far from the door of our church, but for whom our love can mean a better life. Both the church and the world can thus be a true family of God because of our deeds of love.

### WORDS INTO DEEDS

As a church we have said the right words: We have a firm commitment to the equality of women and men.

- We believe in equal pay for work.
- We know that women and men have equally significant contributions to make.
- We want men and women to participate equally in policy making within the church.

But what are the facts that confront us? It is time for the right action! It is time to express ourselves in deed and truth. Let's celebrate the family we are as a church. We are challenged as people of God, who has created all equal, to live out that equality in our homes, our church, and our society.


YOUR PASTOR'S CHRISTMAS CONCERNS




