"Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the source of all mercy and the God of all consolation. He comforts us in all our sorrows so that we can comfort others in their sorrows with the consolation we ourselves have received from God."

These words mark the beginning of the "Order for the Burial of the Dead". They speak to us of two major components of consolation. The first is that God is the source of our consolation. On this day of memorial and celebration, let us remember God's consolation to us. Let us receive with joy, the hope of the Resurrection through Jesus, our Savior. Let us further spread God's consolation to all people in loss and pain.
