9. Inclusion of Stewardship materials regularly in bulletin and newsletter.

To work thru pastor on this

10. United Christian Enlistment (Coordination with Finance Committee)

Are we to understand this has to do with "money", if so we would like to have a clearer understanding on this matter.

11. Recognition of special honors, talents, gifts, etc.

Who determines what type of recognition is to be given and what does a person, group or etc. have to do to receive same

12. Neighborhood membership survey

13. Adopt-a-Grandparent Project for members.

We understand this phase is already in operation but we would like to have more information on the matter.

14. Talent search and data bank of member interests.

We took from this the type of job a person is doing that can be related in some way to our Church needs - more information

15. Intake of data regarding Goals and Objectives

1. To contact church secretary to obtain a list of the envelopes not picked up and phone members if possible. A phone call to be made first, no response, will follow-up with a letter.
