A. Accomplishments:

This process is still in operation and has substantial support within the total congregation through member/leader involvement in this process.

In this unified way, duplication of efforts and unnecessary expense can be avoided, rumors dispelled, and a new kind of unity experienced by the entire congregation.
4. That the themes of faithful stewardship and outreaching evangelism be considered priorities of the congregation until such time as our new goals and objectives are developed and approved by the Congregation at a Congregational Meeting.
