

PROPOSED CHANGES TO THE CONSTITUTION  
OF THE  
UNITED EVANGELICAL CHURCH YOUTH GROUP

Change #1:

ARTICLE II - Membership

Section I - Application For Membership

*PASSED*

which now reads: To become a member of the Youth Group, you must be of confirmation age or above and must be in attendance at three (3) consecutive meetings. If for any reason you cannot be in attendance at these first three meetings, the president should be notified.

shall now read: To become a member of the Youth Group, you must be of confirmation age or above and must be in attendance at three (3) consecutive meetings. If for any reason you cannot be in attendance at these first three meetings, the President or secretary should be notified.

Change #2:

ARTICLE III - Administration

Section I - Election of Officers

*FAILED*

which now reads: The officers shall be elected through a secret ballot by a majority vote on the first meeting date of November in each year. Term of Office: one (1) year. Re-election possible.

shall now read: The officers shall be elected through a secret ballot by a majority vote on the first meeting date of November in each year. Term of office: President is entitled to one re-election after serving one year. Any other executive can serve 1 year, be re-elected as many times as running for office or be elected to another office.

Change #3:

Section III - Duties of Officers

The President's Cabinet

which now reads: This cabinet shall consist of four or five members, who advise the president when asked.

shall now read: To include past presidents to be allowed to attend executive meetings. This executive committee shall meet once a month to discuss

Change #4:

ARTICLE IV - Activities

Section II - Approval

which now reads: From the selections of ideas given by the Planning Committee there will be a show of hands. The majority of the votes to which ideas is given shall be the activity to be approved by at least one adult advisor. If the activity is approved by both parties, a date will be voted on in the same manner as ~~above~~ above. Activities may be suggested from the floor at the time of voting.

shall now read: From the selections of ideas given by the Planning Committee there will be a vote. Approval of a motion will be determined by secret ballots. The majority of the votes to which ideas is given shall be the activity to be approved by at least one adult advisor. If the activity is approved by both parties, a date will be voted on in the same manner as above. Activities may be suggested from the floor at the time of voting.

Change #5:

Change #6:

ARTICLE V - Adult Advisors

which now reads: The Youth Group shall have 2 adult advisors who will assist and guide the group in their activities.

shall now read: The Youth Group shall have two or more adult advisors who will assist and guide the group in their activities.

Change #7:

ARTICLE VI - Meetings Dates

**FAILED**  
Section II - Smoking

Amendment: Smoking shall be prohibited during the 2-5 home youth meetings. Also smoking shall be prohibited during executive meetings.

Change #8:

Change #9:
