The State Environmental Protection people were here and we agreed on the plan for lead abatement to meet the state requirements. Bill Myers has offered to complete the lead abatement work and to take a special 6 hour course to qualify him to do this work.

The boiler has a leak in it and Jim will have the plumber to come in to try to find the leak and repair it.

The fire alarm system has been completed and Jim asked to give George Nassner and his friend some compensation for their work.

A round of applause was given to George Nassner for a job well done.
