The Church Council did not meet in August.

The regular meeting of the Church Council of the United Evangelical Church U>C.C. was held on Tuesday, September 12, 1995.

Those in attendance were Ruth Beckwith, George Finnerty, Robert Jackson, Art Jones, George Nassner, Clarence Rowell, Jim Tallagsen, Bill Voelker, and Cass Young.

Pastor Armstrong opened with prayer.

Bill Voelker made a motion and Ruth seconded to dispense with the reading of the minutes.

Robert Jackson gave the financial report and we are \$2946.48 under budget for the month of August.

A question was raised on the amount that was budgeted for employee's social security. A motion was made by Bill Voelker and seconded by Ruth for Rob to look into this and report back to us at our next meeting. All Council members agreed on this motion.

#### CORRESPONDENCE:

We received three thank you cards from the families of Margaret Waltmyer, Ruth Whitehair, and Marianna Carrigan for our memorials we sent.

We received a letter from U.C.C. Central Atlantic Conference informing us of the fall meeting to be held on Sunday, October 15, 1995 at Zion Evangelical Lutheran U.C.C. in Golden Ring Cooperative Apartments. (See attached) George Finnerty volunteered to go and see if he could get one or more of the Congregation to go with him.

A letter was received from Elizabeth Klose, piano teacher, requesting to change her day to give piano lessons from Tuesday to Friday. Council gave her permission.

The Ladies' Organizations would like to donate \$2000.00 to buy a new refrigerator. Jim estimated it may cost about \$2700.00. Council agreed that the Choir can invite the Brass Band back again for the celebration on our 122nd Church Anniversary on October 1, 1995.

Council agreed to run one more ad in the Guide for the P.A.C.T. program.

Ruth and Cass are on the committee to recruit new members for the 1996 Council.
