Dear Reverend:

The recent shooting of three year old James Smith, III reminded me once again of the many funerals I have attended for people murdered in our City. This senseless killing and all others should cause us collectively to loudly say, "Enough Is Enough!"

I am asking you to please join me in spreading the word that we have had enough. Throughout the month of February every Monday through Saturday, I will be sponsoring a Gun Buy Back Campaign. Anyone who has a gun can turn it in with no questions asked from 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. The turn in locations are the Eastern Health Clinic, 620 North Caroline Street and the Central Neighborhood Service Center, 1901 Pennsylvania Avenue. We will pay \$100 for each gun that is turned in.

In addition to the Gun Buy Back Campaign, the Police Department is also sponsoring a Gun Bounty Program, seeking illegal guns being carried on the streets or guns that may have been involved in a homicide. Anyone who calls "9-1-1" to report such a firearm will collect a \$100 reward, once the police make an arrest associated with that call. The individuals who call "9-1-1" to report an illegal handgun will remain ANONYMOUS!

As we kick off these two programs, I am asking you to join me in a Candle Light Ceremony memorializing the victims of violence, on Friday, January 31, 1997 at 6:30 p.m. in front of City Hall at 100 North Holliday Street.

Please announce these activities from your pulpit. Would you also place this information in bold print in your church bulletin? I really need your help in letting our citizens know the violence has got to end....Enough Is Enough.






