

FATHER'S DAY MESSAGE

June 15, 1997

These are difficult days for Father. For most fathers today the former role as sole provider for the family has gone. As the sign down at the local Chevron Station says: "If you aren't harried, worried, and a little bit nuts you don;t understand what's going on around here." The traditional notions of manhood are under attack and men are being called upon to defend themselves, to change, to become something other than what they have been.

Ask most any man, How does it feel to be a man these days? Do you feel manhood is honored, respected, celebrated?" Many men feel as if they are involved in a night battle in a jungle against an unseen foe. Voices from the darkness shout "Men are too aggressive. Too soft, too insensitive, too macho, too power mad. Too much like little boys. Too wimpy. Too violent. Too obsessed with sex. Too detached to care. Too busy. Too rational. Too lost to lead. Too dead to feel." EXACTLY WHAT THEY ARE SUPPOSED TO BECOME IS NOT CLEAR.

These are times when both men and women can turn to the Church to find answers. Jesus gives us the model for manhood which is being rediscovered anew today.
