

WHAT WILL WE DO WITH JESUS OF NAZARETH?
WHAT WILL WE DO WITH THE CARPENTER KING?

Judas, like many of us, had been caught up in serving a man, a leader of the people who had great possibilities of doing good and now at Easter He was proving to be a different person than the simple carpenter. If He had remained so, we could have handled Him: but that was not to be. That part of Jesus upset Judas. As long as He stayed a bright, alert man, simply a smart carpenter, a great unknown, He'd have caused nobody harm; but now we know He's different, and like Judas, we become frightened. This Jesus was teaching about a new kingdom. He taught about the eternal life and about heaven and people were believing this nonsense. These "followers Of The Way", said Judas, had "too much heaven on their minds". The concern Judas had with Jesus, is our problem. We came to church to learn about morality and giving to the poor and Jesus talks about change-being born again-turning the other cheek, making a right about face in our lives, loving people whom we'd rather not love, laying down our life for our friends, organizing against hunger, choosing a whole new way of life and going to rooms eternal and in the heavens. Like Judas, we did not bargain for this! What then, will we do with Jesus of Nazareth? What will we do with the carpenter King? That is the question which haunts us and especially at Easter.



FATHER'S DAY MESSAGE

June 21, 1998


Night of Christ and Glory
