



## FATHER'S DAY MESSAGE

June 20, 1999

These are difficult days for Father. For most fathers today the former role as sole provider for the family has gone. As the sign down at the local Chevron Station says: "If you aren't harried, worried, and a little bit nuts you don't understand what's going on around here." The traditional notions of manhood are under attack and men are being called upon to defend themselves, to change, to become something other than what they have been.

Ask most any man, How does it feel to be a man these days? Do you feel manhood is honored, respected, celebrated? Many men feel as if they are involved in a night battle in a jungle against an unseen foe. Voices from the darkness shout "Men are too aggressive. Too soft, too insensitive, too macho, too power mad. Too much like little boys. Too wimpy. Too violent. Too obsessed with sex. Too detached to care. Too busy. Too rational. Too lost to lead. Too dead to feel." EXACTLY WHAT THEY ARE SUPPOSED TO BECOME IS NOT CLEAR.

These are times when both men and women can turn to the Church to find answers. Jesus gives us the model for manhood which is being rediscovered anew today. JESUS WAS A POWERFUL, FOCUSED, FEARLESS, CARING, COMMITTED, AND COMPASSIONATE MAN. "GREATER LOVE", HE SAID, "HAS NO MAN THAN THAT HE WOULD LAY DOWN HIS LIFE FOR HIS FRIEND".

A man, today, must go on a quest to discover the sacred fire in the sanctuary of his own belly, to ignite the flame in his heart, to fuel the blaze in the hearth, to rekindle his ardor for the earth. \* Men can not be good fathers till they discover what it means to be good men.

Today we remember lives of fathers who have gone on that quest before us. They are our heritage and we loved them very much. For them death is passed and pain is ended and we rejoice that they have entered the eternal life in Christ Jesus.







## MEMORIAL SUNDAY (TOTENFEST)

Rudyard Kipling's most fondly remembered poem "Recessional" ends with the line, "O Lord of Hosts, be with us yet, lest we forget--lest we forget."

Recently, a dear friend was told he was sinking slowly into Alzheimer's Disease, a progressive loss of memory. "He may live some years after his memory is completely gone," said the doctor, pointing out our friend's excellent physical condition. How can we continue our close and mutual trust if he doesn't remember-- doesn't, even remember us?

For the patient himself, loss of memory has no suffering. But for the rest of us, most of our intimacy with our loved ones relates to our common memories, those times and experiences which we felt together and enjoy recalling. The real tragedy is on all sides, because honoring the treasures we share is what makes life so full. Except within the Communion of Saints where there is a belongingness that can never be broken by disease or death.

While we have the memories of our loved ones to keep with us and comfort us, we can rejoice that for them, their memories have a new holy dimension. Christ himself promised that he would go before us and prepare a place for us in God's home. When Christ gave us eternal life through his death and resurrection, he gave us the assurance and comfort that our departed ones will always live in the loving embrace of God. When Jesus promised that he would never leave us orphaned, and that where he is, we will be also, we can be confident of a permanent belonging to the community of faith.

Here at United Evangelical Church we have established a special way to honor our loved ones. On Sunday, November 21st, the day we the the Festival of Christ Our King, we will have a day of remembrance and healing, especially recalling names of those recently called to the Eternal Community, in a worship celebration and committal.

Our faith offers us a rich tradition of hope and assurance at this time. Just as ancient Israel institutionalized their history of Deliverance from Egypt in the family ritual of Passover by retelling it every year in th family circle, so within our family circle at United we keep alive on this day of remembrance the record of a dear relative, friend, teacher, grandparent, or admired leader. Each will be remembered and lifted up in prayer that day, knowing that Christ is King, and nothing will ever be able to separate His love from us. Those families who have had a loved one pass away in this past church year will also receive a rose.

These memorials and love gifts will be used for the on going work of the church or for a special gift that you may name. They may also be in the form of a special gift to the Church. One of the wreaths was brightly decorated with red ribbons, but the other was stark, with only a black ribbon on it. It was a funeral wreath.

He felt compelled to knock at their door. After he identified himself as a minister of a nearby congregation, the young father invited him into the very still living room where a coal fire was warming the still space. And there, in the middle of the room, was a small casket containing the body of his young daughter, and an empty chair where the father had been sitting, keeping watch beside the body of his child.

Rev. Peale was very moved as he realized that this young family was alone on Christmas Eve, in a new neighborhood, with no friends or relatives. The father seemed to read his inquiring mind and replied, "It's all right, she's with the Lord, you know." Then the father took the young minister into a bedroom to introduce him to his wife who was reading to two small boys.



promise that underlies Christmas: 'Because I live, ye shall live also.' They had heard it and they believed it. That was why they could move forward together with love and dignity, courage and acceptance."

"So that was the gift I, (a young minister) received that year, the reaffirmation that the myrrh in the Christmas story is not just a reminder of death, but a symbol of the love that triumphs over death."

This moving story reminded me that here at United Evangelical Church, we have two symbols in our sanctuary, which when combined into one, signify life and death. The cross. These two were made into one with Christ's death and resurrection. So it is quite appropriate that we celebrate the full cycle of God's creation by remembering the birth and death of those whom we have loved, those whom God created and called His own, those who are now experiencing the gift of eternal life with God. So this Christmas, let us celebrate the birth of God's new love, God's special blessing in Jesus, by gathering together in worship and by remembering them with special memorial gifts.


