

IMPORTANT CHANGE OF ADDRESS NOTICE





Finally, the angel bent over and ran her finger across the cheek. "There's a leak," she pronounced. "I told you, You were trying to put too much into this model."



"It's not a leak," said the Lord, "It's a tear."

TO HIS MOTHER


"Mother-in-law they say, and yet,

**You are invited to join the choir for these two events!**


**Sunday, August 29, 1999 - 10:00 a.m.**
