FRONT DOORS OF CHURCH

As property chairman, I have been trying for sometime to find, or hire, someone with wood finishing skills to properly refinish the church front doors without success. Finishing the doors is not just a matter of simply painting them, it is a rather long process. The outside of the doors are in such a condition that they must first be scraped, sanded, filled, sanded again, neutralized, sanded again, stained, apply a coat of sanding sealer, sanded again, then given a coat of satin varnish, light rubbed down with steel wool then another coat of varnish. In addition to the finishing, they are also in need of some repair work. PURPOSE


Today, and on the following two Sundays, religious themes and symbols will be emphasized to assist the people of United Evangelical Church in exploring the meaning of their individual faith as well as the faith of United Church as the body of Christ.

The themes of the three Sundays were chosen by a group (chaired by President George Nassner) formed from the church council. The themes were developed from a list of essential beliefs that the church counsel drew up at a retreat and shared with the people of United Church last February. As the people of United Church share another Anniversary Sunday together on September 24th, the emphasis will be on how the church has shared its faith throughout its history.

The theme for today is the Holy Spirit as symbolized by the dove.

THE DOVE A Symbol of the Holy Spirit

The dove is the traditional symbol of the Holy Spirit, for it was the dove who brought news to Noah that the flood was over. At the baptism of Jesus, it was "The Spirit of God descending like a dove and alighting on Jesus" who brought news to all people of the true identity of Jesus as "God's Son, the Beloved, with whom I am well pleased." The dove symbolizes the church, God's people being filled "with the Spirit of God, in wisdom and understanding, in knowledge and counsel". The dove also symbolizes God's people using the many gifts and talents given to them by the Holy Spirit to love and praise God by loving and serving one another.



PURPOSE

When we pray for the coming of the HOLY SPIRIT, symbolized last Sunday by the DOVE from the Baptism of Jesus, we pray for Wisdom, Understanding, Knowledge and Counsel for ourselves and our ministry in United Church.

In today's symbol, JESUS, THE GOOD SHEPHERD, we remember the eternal care and love given us by Jesus. In humbleness we pray for the Holy Spirit to guide us in the ways of Christ's love and service.

JESUS, THE GOOD SHEPHERD

"I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd lays down his life for the sheep. I know my own and my own know me, just as the Father knows me and I know the Father. And I lay down my life for the sheep. For this reason the Father loves me, because I lay down my life in order to take it up again." John 10:11

In the New Testament, it is Christ's mission to be the chief Shepherd. Even as the shepherd guides the flock to green pastures and wards off the predators of the forest, so does the abiding spirit of the Good Shepherd abide with us day and night, through all eternity. "I will come again and will take you to myself" Jesus told his disciples (John 14:3) The shepherd with his flock is the symbol for the one who lays down his life for us, as in Psalm 23.

"The LORD is my shepherd; I shall not want.
He makes me to lie down in green pastures;
He leads me beside the still waters. He restores my soul;
He leads me in the paths of righteousness For His name's sake.
Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death,
I will fear no evil; For You are with me;

You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies;
You anoint my head with oil; My cup runs over.


