

Dear Daddy,

Now that you're gone, and I don't have an earthly father any more, I find as I celebrate my first Father's day without you, that I want to celebrate your life as my father.

I have had so many wonderful memories of you this springtime. As I was planting some Nasturtium seeds a couple of weeks ago, I could suddenly hear your voice through the late afternoon breezes calling me, "Little Chum, come help me plant the garden." I closed my eyes, and suddenly you were there showing me how to lay the seeds carefully in the straight rows we had just made, warning me not to plant them too deep! I felt your hand over mine as you helped me carry the "it's too heavy, Daddy" water bucket to give the seeds their first drink.

But, too quickly, my eyes open as a car drives past, and I know that I am not with you on the farm after all. Please know that I will always miss you, but in the way God made this glorious universe that you taught me to love, we all have to go on when we lose a dear one.

I remember when I would bring your four o'clock snack out to the field you were working in, and you would let us sit in the big hollow tree as we ate.

There was something very worshipful about being out in the open fields with you on those sunny days. You taught me to treat the earth, the trees, especially the water as if God handed them to me personally. You said God made all that I could see, from horizon to horizon, but we must treat it with great care. You said many things like that about God. You were a man of faith, steady in your loyalty to Christ's church.

You never missed a Sunday taking us to church. Even when the crops needed harvesting or the hay was

down and would be rained on if we didn't stay home to bale it; you would not violate your basic ethics and principles, even if it cost you a lower crop yield, so off to church we went. I learned to put worshipping God as the highest priority of the week, because you said, "if God only worked on six days, so should we." Because of what you taught us, my brother and I have honored the importance of the spiritual. That was your standard and it became ours, too.

David and I honored your prayers, your daily devotions, your Christian convictions, and your godly life. As it is said, "Children never have been very good at listening to their parents, but they have never failed to imitate them."

You were dedicated to your family. We were always secure in the knowledge that you loved us and protected us. "A man prides himself on his strength," goes the old adage, "but when his child is born he discovers that strength is not enough, and that he must learn gentleness." You had the biggest, strongest hands any of us ever saw, yet you were always and foremost, a "gentleman"!

You opened the doors of the full life to us. You gave us what we needed, you stood by and let us learn some things the hard way; you always encouraged us.

Yes, you have gone to be with your parents, brothers, and sisters. However, David and I have more than memories to recall and enjoy. We have you within us, in our characters, ethics, faith, and outlook on life.

From The Pastor

I have always admired Abraham Lincoln. Yes, I was raised in Lincoln land, a few miles from New Salem, Illinois. Yes, I regularly walked by his old law office where he and his partner, Billy Herdon, burnt many a midnight lamp. Yes, the Court House where he practiced law still stands tall and groomed in the middle of Springfield, Illinois -- a beacon to justice and fairness for all.

But what I most remember is touring his home and hearing about his personal family life. As we toured the Lincoln Home, I was in good company with many others who stopped to look at Tad's room. Tad, Mr. Lincoln's beloved son who died at such a young age. It broke Mr. Lincoln's heart - it was said about Mrs. Lincoln that she never recovered - his depression and her mental state were whispered about town in those days.

What must Christmas have been like for the Lincoln's? Did they speak often of what Tad would be doing if he were here?

Sitting one day in the "Lincoln Pew" at the downtown Presbyterian Church in Springfield, I wondered if Tad would go along on Christmas Eve to sing the carols that spoke of "Peace on Earth" - if he and Mr. Lincoln would walk hand-in-hand the few blocks back to their two story white home with green shutters. Would they be greeted by *real* candles in the windows?

Yes, Mr. Lincoln knew what it was like to grieve and remember a loved one, especially at Christmas. In local author Pat Cochran's excellent new book, *LAST RIGHTS, Taking Care With Your Final Journey*, I found a quote of Mr. Lincoln's.

*In this sad world of ours, sorrow comes to all,
and it often comes with bitter agony.
Perfect relief is not possible, except with time.
You cannot now believe that you will ever feel better.
But this is not true. You are sure to be happy again.
Knowing this, truly believing it, will make you less miserable now.
I have had enough experience to make this statement.*

Slowly, we learn when we experience death, our grief is not an interruption of life. Our grief is part of life. We are meant to be present to our grief and to those around us who grieve.

We smile to ourselves when we find ourselves observing family habits and customs just as our Dad did, such as putting up the tree after soaking it in a tub for exactly *three* days - or baking Christmas cookies just like Mom or Grandmom did.

And these tributes say, "Thank you loved one for what of you is in me, thank you God for loving me through my spouse, or parent or other loved one."


