Henry Feldmann was born of Christian Feldmann and Henrietta G. D. nee Vinup who were among the founders of United Ch. Christian died of smallpox Feb. 3, 1883 and Mother and 4 children moved back to the little house at 1102 S. Curley St. She made her living at dressmaking and daughter Henrietta helped at sewing by age of 10. Henry is supposed to have been carried to cornerstone laying of church on horseback.

He and Henrietta went to the German Day School at the church. All 4 children attended S.S. Henry became Supt. of Beginners Dept. and was also Sect. of S.S. for a number of years.

He and his wife were very active in the Young People's League in its early days.

He was not able to attend church as regularly after his wife became an invalid with shaking Palsy. After her death he attended regularly again. After his step daughter's death, he lived alone for about a year, then went with his granddaughter who later moved to Parkville. He still attended quite regularly until about 1958 when he began to fail so he could not ride the buses and street-cars alone. Now at 89 years, he gets in occasionally.

Mar. 23, 1902 Henry married Mrs. Katherine Lell nee (Schriber) who had a daughter Elizabeth (married by Pastor W. Batz) Daughter Elizabeth married Edward Wilkman (Pastor Batz) Erma - listed on other side - The "Kidd's") transferred to St. John's about 9 or 10 yrs. ago.
