

# Canton Church Service to Note Hundreth Year

Centennial Sunday tomorrow will be observed at 10 a.m. at United Evangelical Church, Canton, which this month is observing the 100th anniversary of its founding.

Theme of the service will be "Past, Present and Future of United Church."

Speaker will be Dr. Paul Lehmann, who is both an outstanding theologian and a "family" member of United Church.

A faculty member at Union Theological Seminary, New York City, Dr. Lehmann is a nephew of the late Rev. Titus Lehmann, pastor of United Church from 1934 until his retirement in 1961.

During Pastor Lehmann's administration, the present church building was completed at cost of approximately \$300,000.

Special music will be a feature of the Centennial Service.

The Senior Choir will pre-

sent two anniversary anthems: "The Heavens are Telling" by Haydn and "And the Glory of the Lord" from Handel's "Messiah."

On Sept. 29 the anniversary banquet will be held at Eastwind. J. Edwin Meyers is chairman of the anniversary. The Rev. Paul A. Rasche is pastor.
