

RESOLUTION ON THE PASSING OF

**Adam Trautner**

ADOPTED BY THE CHURCH COUNCIL OF

**United Evangelical Church, Baltimore, Maryland**

At a meeting of the Church Council of United Evangelical Church, Baltimore, Md., held on the second day of September, nineteen hundred and forty-one, the following tribute to the memory of Adam Trautner was offered and unanimously adopted.

On August the twenty-first, nineteen hundred and forty-one, Adam Trautner, one-time president of United Evangelical Church and member of its official board at the time of his decease, oft-elected delegate to Conference and Synod meetings, the representative of the Church on the Baltimore Council of Churches, was called by his Master out of the church militant to the life triumphant.

He was an honest and friendly business man. He was an ardent and faithful church-man, who was vitally interested in his own Church, as well as in the larger Kingdom work. His personality and his counsel will be greatly missed.

To his family, the Church Council on behalf of United Evangelical Church, expresses deepest sympathy and assures it that in the living God and in Jesus Christ, the Resurrection and Life, it can find comfort and strength to carry on the task our deceased loved so well.
