In Memorial

The Rev. Robert M. Armstrong, 71, died on Sunday, November 14, 1999 after a long illness.

Rev. Armstrong recently retired as Pastor of the United Evangelical United Church of Christ in Baltimore, MD, where he served for nine years. Rev. Armstrong received his M.Div from the University of Chicago. Bob was ordained by the Presbytery of Chicago in 1959. He held United Church of Christ standing in the Chesapeake Association.

Prior to his pastorate at United Evangelical, he had over 30 years experience as the Chief Executive Officer, or Administrator in nursing homes, senior apartments and Continuing Care Retirement Communities. During his career in caring for the aged, he established Teaching Nursing Homes, and served as mentor for 20 administrators-in-training.

Rev. Armstrong is survived by his wife of 50+ years, Priscilla, two children, Keith Robert Armstrong and Sarah Alice Hermann, three grandchildren, a twin sister, Evelyn Fisher and a brother Richard William Armstrong.
