I am writing to you as the Attorney for Kenneth H. Gegner who is the Personal Representative of the Estate of Thomas P. Amrhien.

The purpose of this letter is to inform you of the usual procedure in a regular probate Estate and how your legacy is stated in the Will by reference to the enclosed excerpt of the Will.


In the near future you will receive in accordance with the law a photocopy of the Notice to Creditors and Interested Persons by certified mail of the newspaper notice to appear three times in the Dalley Record newspaper.

Within three months, the Inventory of assets owned by Thomas at the time of his death should be filed with the Register of Wills for Baltimore City. This inventory will place a value on his residence, furniture, stocks, bank accounts, and any other assets of value solely owned by him.

After the notice to creditors expires about six months from now, we should be able to file what is commonly known as a First Administration Account. If a Federal Estate Tax Form 706 becomes necessary, a Final Account will be deferred.
