INTERIM INTERLUDES

They tell me that Jesus rose from the dead. All four of the gospels in the New Testament tell of it. It's a fantastic, incredible story. I wasn't there; therefore, all that I know about it has come from the scriptures and from the voice of the church. I don't understand it; I can't explain it. It just doesn't make any sense at all. Yet, I believe it to be true, with all my heart.

Have you ever been relaxing near a calm lake or riverbank and suddenly hear the splash of one or more pebbles? And then, turning around, you see a girl or boy standing by intently watching the circles on top of the water, as they begin to spread out and out. Now, you didn't see the child throw the pebbles in the water, but you *heard* the splash, and you *see* the results. You see the ripples on the surface of the water spreading in every direction. You smile, amused at the children, and don't even question that those pebbles hit the water – because *you heard, and you saw.*

Just so with the Resurrection of Christ. From that happening centuries ago, visible ripples have been going on, like shock waves all over the world.

It was *because* of the Easter story that Stephen gave his life,
It was *because* of the Easter story that Paul walked three times around
the world of his day,

It is *because* of the Easter story that millions of lives are turned around.

It is *because* of the Easter story that the *Declaration of Independence* of our country was written by people who respected God's creation, who enacted principles of law, order, justice, and compassion.

I believe, because I do personally experience the presence of the Holy Spirit in my life. Jesus promised that he would send the Holy Spirit to be with us when he left on his last evening with his friends, and so he did!

God's presence walked the earth in human form, and then was released to be everywhere bringing forgiveness to the guilty, healing to the sick, reconciliation to the angry, and love to the lonely.

That's why Easter Day is the great festival of resurrected life – because of Christ's resurrection, our life can have a fresh start – we are not tied to the past. We have a new future! Do you believe that? Come, all of you, near and far, come, all of you who have been away too long, come, for the Easter celebration is for you. As the old gospel song goes:

*Because He lives I can face tomorrow;
Because He lives all fear is gone;
Because I know He holds the future,
And life is worth the living just because He lives.*
