

UNITED EVANGELICAL UNITED CHURCH OF CHRIST
CONGREGATIONAL MEETING
NOVEMBER 30, 1997

The Congregational meeting of the United Evangelical Church United Church of Christ was held on November 30, 1997.

There were 65 people who attended the meeting.

FINANCIAL REPORT:

Harvey Jacobs informed the Congregation that the total Church balance is \$168,344. It was reported that the total cost of the boiler was \$65,569. As of this date, approximately \$48,000 has been paid back.

Cal Gundlach presented the proposed budget for 1998. After review, Bill Voelker motioned to accept, Darlene Waters seconded. All present were in favor.

Question was raised by Lou Parker - rate of interest earned with \$100,000 in Eastern Savings. Harvey Jacob answered - 5.9%.

ELECTION OF COUNCIL MEMBERS:

Olga deBloom; Cal Gundlach; Harvey Jacob; Bill Meyers; John Price. All these individuals agreed to run again.

A new Congregational member agreed to run: Elizabeth Weitzel.

George Nassner will rerun and was duly elected. Ed Meyers motioned, Edgar Livingston seconded. All Council members were requested to attend our next Council meeting.

Clarence Rowell presented a check to Cal Gundlach in the amount of \$500 from the Church School to be used for the Boiler Fund.

Pastor Armstrong presented a \$200 check for a donation for a memorial to the Church in memory of his brother-in-law.

Rev. Roy Joellenbeck expressed his gratitude in allowing him to participate in our Church.

It was motioned by Bill Voelker and seconded by Darlene Waters to adjourn.
