CHURCH COUNCIL MEETING  
MARCH 11, 1999

The regular meeting of Church Council of the United Evangelical Church was held on Thursday, March 11, 1999.

Minutes were read and approved. Harvey gave financial report for Cal. During the month of February, \$8,200 was taken in. The Church spent a total of \$11,709. \$4,500 was spent more this year than previous. Totals included appraisal of School Building = \$650 (up front).
